MISSION

The Issaquah/Sammamish Chapter of the National League of Young Men, Inc. was founded in September 2015 with the goal of providing young men an opportunity to serve their community while gaining valuable leadership skills along with protocol knowledge and cultural experiences.

This program is open to young men (and their mothers) who attend Issaquah, Skyline, Eastlake, or Eastside Catholic HS and/or reside in Issaquah, Sammamish, and a small area of Bellevue (within the Issaquah School District).

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Each young man is required to complete 10 philanthropic hours and 6 league hours per year. They are also required to participate in 2 hours of cultural activities.

- ◆ Philanthropic hours may be earned in any endeavor where the young men are giving volunteer service at either a NLYM organized philanthropic event and/or any established philanthropic organization, school or community based group.

Mothers are expected to attend 3 out of 5 meetings per year with the goal being two-fold:

- 1) To support their young men
- 2) To hear from notable guest speakers

- ◆ Mothers are required to serve either on one league committee or on the Chapter Board each year along with one grade level position per son.
